Recommendation 1:

Richard Hay, CBC's Clerk, recommends that we remove Mary Cox as a member of CBC since she has joined Westwood Baptist church in Des Moines, Iowa and that we add Mary Jenkins as a CBC member.

Recommendation 2:

The Nominating Committee recommends that we elect the following individuals to serve:

Recommendation 3:

The Stewardship Committee recommends that we transfer \$150,000.00 from the CBC checking account to a 9-month certificate of deposit at the Bank of Springfield. We recommend that Treasurer Scott Clifford, and Assistant Treasurers William Jacobs plus Mike Chosich serve as signers on the CD.

Cheryl Reindl recommends that we ask the Constitution Committee to reverse the 90% majority vote to call a senior pastor back to the original 75% majority to call a senior pastor.
